Rare wall shelf unit by Florence Knoll. Made by Knoll International, Stuttgart in 1952.

Cabinets and shelves are made of teak. The interiors are veneered with maple. Cabinet fronts in white. The doors of the cabinet modules elegantly sink into the bottom of the slopes after opening, which also allows for permanently open use - as no doors protrude into the room. The shelves are each variable in height.

The wall panels are covered with seaweed (the fourth panel is present, but not visible in the photos - you can also omit the panels and have as a background the color of your respective wall...
